RESERVATION POLICY

The college has adopted fully the reservation rules as prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu for admission to Arts and Science colleges. The college is committed to follow the rules in letter and spirit.

Rule of Reservation

The admission should be made purely on the basis of Merit subject to the rule of reservation of the Government of Tamil Nadu.

- 31 % for Open Competition (OC)
- 30 % for Backward Classes (BC) within which 3.5 % is earmarked for Muslims
- 20 % for Most Backward classes (MBC) and Denotified Communities
- 18 % for Scheduled Castes (SC) within which 3 % of seats is earmarked for Arunthathiyars (which includes Adi Andhra)
- 1 % for Scheduled Tribes (ST)

For UG Courses, Tamil Nadu +2 candidates alone will be considered for communal reservation. Candidates who have studied +2 outside Tamil Nadu will be considered as OC. However, SC/ST candidates are exempt from this rule.

For PG Courses, Candidates having Community Certificates issued in States other than Tamil Nadu will be considered under OC / Merit quotas only.

The rule of reservation will apply to:

90 % seats in MSW Aided course
50 % seats in all other courses (self-financed)

- The candidates under MGT quota will be selected by the Board of Management.
- The quota for Management in Unaided courses has been allocated within the 50 % seats available for the Management to ensure that a clear 50 % of seats is filled as per reservation rules.
- For MSW (A) and MSW (SF), the community quota allocations have to be further divided according to specializations based on department decision.

Quota for Differently Aabled

The college is expected to fill up 5 out of every 100 seats within merit or community quotas with differently abled candidates. It amounts to approximately 18 seats across the various courses within the merit or community quotas. Each department must ensure that at least 1 seat is allocated to this category of students.

Quota for Ex-servicemen

The College is expected to reserve 3 seats for children of ex-servicemen of **Tamil Nadu origin** combined for all its PG courses within the merit / community quotas and 2 seats in UG courses.

Quota for outstanding Sportspersons / NCC Cadets

The College is expected to reserve 3% seats in UG courses combined and 2% seats in all the PG courses combined for outstanding Sportspersons who have represented at District / Divisional level and above. This will be within the merit / community quotas. UG courses can make full use of this provision and admit accomplished sports persons.

One seat in UG courses combined and One seat in PG courses combined is reserved for NCC cadets (with A / B certificates).

Filling up un-filled reserved seats

On the last date of admission, unfilled SC/ST vacancies can be filled by MBC/DNC candidates. Unfilled MBC/DNC seats can be filled by BC candidates. Unfilled BC vacancies can be filled up by other communities
