6. The mentor will decide on the agenda according to the needs of the group / individual.
7. Mentoring record will be maintained by the respective mentors.
8. Mentoring will begin from the beginning of academic year and will end at the end/closure of the academic years.
9. Mentoring program is flexible and will be designed by the respective mentors.
10. The mentor will use his/her discretion to refer the mentees for other required support services if required. .
