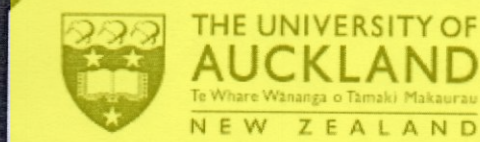

Please note there is no guarantee that the same decision (i.e. an offer or conditional offer) will be made to your deferred application. This is because admission requirements and availability of programmes vary between academic years and semesters.

**Important information for international students**

If you are currently in New Zealand and planning to enrol for Semester Two 2020, you must apply for a student visa and have it approved by 27 July.

If you are currently outside of New Zealand, as there is no date set for lifting of border restrictions, do not apply for a student visa. You can study online without a visa, or you have the option of deferring to Semester One 2021.

Students currently in China have the option of studying at one of our [University of Auckland China Learning Centres](#) without a visa for Semester Two 2020.

When New Zealand's border restrictions are lifted, you can provide evidence of your online study to support your visa application. Visit [Immigration New Zealand's website](#) for more information.
