Mobile Phone Usage Guidelines for Students

Inside Campus

The Directorate of Collegiate Education has issued a circular (No.5411/A3/2018 dated 16.08.2018) asking Colleges to ban the use of mobile phones within the College premises. In accordance with this communication, students are prohibited from using mobile phones inside the Classrooms, Conference hall, Auditorium and the open air theatre during lectures, events and meetings and any location within the campus in which students are instructed not to use mobile phones from time to time.

Phones used in the above locations will be confiscated and handed over to the Principal. The phones will be returned only at the end of the academic year after end semester examinations. All Faculty and Admin staff are empowered to take action in this regard. Any student obstructing the faculty/admin staff from confiscating the phone will face disciplinary action.

In Field Work / Other official venues

We have received complaints from Field Work / Internship organizations about inappropriate mobile use during work time, lectures and training programmes. Students are warned not to use mobile phones during field work except for official purposes and avoid use of mobile phones during lectures, seminars, field visits and training programmes attended outside College. In case we receive complaint against any student, disciplinary action will be initiated against the student.
