Madras School of Social Work (MSSW) established in 1952, located in Chennai South India is an Autonomous Institution, NAAC accredited and affiliated to University of Madras. Madras School of Social Work was founded by Mary Clubwalla Jadhav under the auspicious of Madras state branch of the Indian Conference of Social work (renamed the Indian Council of Social Welfare) and the Guild of service (central). The school is run under the aegis of the Society for Social Education and Research (SSER) the school is rated 3rd best social work college in India and 1st in South India.

MSSW is established with a vision to be global leader in education research and intervention in social work and allied disciplines towards transforming the human potential in to socially sensitive change agents for sustainable development and to create outstanding professionals who will provide transformational leadership in the community and work place.

Holy Cross Service Society, Trichy is working for the Prevention, Cure, Education, Rehabilitation of Persons With Disabilities (PWDs) for over 34 years focusing on equal opportunity and full participation of PWDs to bring about significant positive social, economical, attitudinal and inclusive changes in the life of CWDs and PWDs. As part of this visionary effort, Holy Cross Service Society has become the one stop facility for all the needs of PWDs.

The society had moved to become the professional group to promote not only education to children with disabilities but also skills to youth with disabilities so that they can be employable both in public as well as family related work. As part of this effort, the Holy Cross Service Society Trichy, to upgrade skills of youth with disabilities an Integrated Farm in the outskirts of Trichy at a place Pallakadu /Athavathur and is planning to train 10 youth with disabilities through a certificate course so that they can be skillfully employed in farm related work.

The Holy Cross Service Society Trichy support over 1000 PWDs every year and is now venturing in to offering a certificate course **on Green Enterprises for Person with Disabilities (PWD) in association Department of Social Entrepreneurship Incubation Center , Madras School of Social Work Chennai.**

The following activities will be jointly planned and executed between MSSW- Holy Cross Service Society :

1. **Arrange internships and field visits for MSSW students with Holy Cross Service Society supported projects in Tamil Nadu.**
2. **Collaborate in designing certificate courses;, mentoring and regular degree courses; and post graduate courses.**
3. **Organize seminars/workshops, Symposium and Capacity Building programme on social entrepreneurship ecosystem for Person with Disabilities (PWDs), Parents, workers and NGOs to bring out proceedings as booklets apart from studies on successful social enterprises including short films.**
4. **Offer services in the areas of base line study, Evaluating projects, Monitoring and Evaluation studies as required by Holy Cross Service society.**
5. To make use of the infrastructure established by Holy Cross Service society for Training and conducting courses.

Duration:

This MOU will be effective from the date of signing by both parties up to a period of 5 years and may be subject to extension by mutual consent of the parties in writing. The provisions of this MOU may be amended any time with mutual consent of the parties in writing.

Termination:

Either party may terminate the agreement by giving six months advance notice in writing. The amendment termination and expiration of this MOU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing of the time of notification of amendment, termination or expiration, unless otherwise agreed upon between the two parties.

Each party will take approval from the other party in writing to use the latter's name and logo for the activities hear under on case basis and other party will provide a reply at the earliest or maximum within seven days in writing.

Notices:

Any notice to be given under this MOU shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly and properly served. Found upon the parties hitherto if delivered against acknowledgement of by registered mail addressed to be parties hear in at the addresses given at the initial paragraphs of this MOU or such change address duly notified by the parties.

Terms of Reference (TOR) between MSSW and Holy Cross Service Society

The Holy Cross Service Society Trichy support over 1000 PWDs every year and is now venturing in to offering a certificate course **on Green Enterprises for Person with Disabilities (PWD)** in association Department of Social Entrepreneurship Incubation Center , Madras School of Social Work, Chennai.

- 1) These will be two batches in a year to be trained in this certificate course using the Integrated Farm facility of HCSS with 10 youth with disabilities in a batch.
- 2) The team of this MOU would be valid for a minimum of five years trying to train and promote work skill in farm work for at least 100 youth with disabilities, who can be either self, employed (or) gainfully employed.
- 3) The cost of training at HCSS will be the responsibility of HCSS. But it is also mutually agreed that both parties try to raise funds for the successful implementation of this project.
- 4) Both parties are open to having association with other organization, corporate, etc for the benefit of this project.
- 5) Both the parties will have the liberty to promote, pitch and include association for the success of the project with mutual concerns.
- 6) Wherever applicable the concept patenting and other legalities would be followed mutually. As far as this project is concerned there will be transparent financial engagement till the life time of this MOU.
- 7) It is also agreed that mutually we will ensure spaces for incubators for their operations or works.
- 8) The Madras School of Social Work will provide the certification of the course.
