BETWEEN

It has got two design patent granted out of five patents applied for Solar roofing sheets, solar roofing tiles and developing smart solar irrigation kit, 24X7 energy console, are aimed at rural small holders to enhance livelihoods, agriproductivity, access 24X7 energy to maximize their income opportunities and have smart living spaces. - Develop customized MSSW Learning Management System (LMS) Android Apps for smart class deployment for faculty and students on cost basis in compliance with NAAC guidelines for field work, assignments and academic requirements to pave way for e-library, big data and artificial intelligence in the long run.
- Train the faculty and students in Smart Social Worker App developed for prolific as part of paid training and provide annual maintenance further customization to achieve paperless social work education systems. The MSSW will assist in Smart Social Worker App usage with affiliated colleges, universities, NGO's and other institutes under the Digital India, UGC, MHRD and through other projects to digitize education for MSSW building Social work big data leading to Artificial intelligence.
- Carry out faculty development programs (FDP) for departmental staff, university, affiliate and autonomous colleges in relevant areas of both MSSW and CST.
- CST to support MSSW in establishment of cost effective Smart Classes, optimal Solar Energy systems, Smart Buildings structures where it can provide competitive and comparative advantages.
- CST to support MSSW social enterprise incubation center incubatees with smart apps required for their ventures on cost or equity based, conduct Appathons & Hackathons for social enterprise development, support, guide incubates with establishment of their enterprises and also angel

- Accept MSSW students for field work, block placement, applied research and recruit students to be employees in areas of interest to CST. CST to provide field trainings as part of field work or block placement work to technologically enable Social work students to use Smartphones and get trained in CST's Smart Social Worker App, Smart PRA App, Smart Farmer Apps, Save Indian Livestock Breeds etc. with various farmer groups in various ongoing projects with ongoing project, Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs), Self-help Groups (SHGs) and Village Organizations (VO's) to enhance future proof skill based education for sustainable employment at National and International levels
- MSSW and CST will jointly or form consortium with other agencies to develop project proposals, raise funds, for Seminars, Trainings, Surveys, Research Studies, Workshops, CSR activities, participate in bidding and implement jointly or subcontract or work part of a consortium with other development agencies or private companies complimenting with their respective strengths with scope for Android and web app development. Funding obtained for such joint projects will be held separately under project specific sub accounts which will be audited and statement of accounts in accordance to prevailing Indian laws will be submitted separately by relevant accounting officials and books of accounts will be maintained in accordance to prevailing national laws.

Both the organizations will share information relating to common cause from time to time for wider use of ICT by rural communities for betterment of livelihoods using smartphone app, Internet of Things, big data and Artificial intelligence.

The copyright of the information resides with MSSW and CST for all purposes deemed fit for academic, research, policy, publication and wider dissemination. The Department of Social work and CST may publish the copy right information with adequately acknowledging the authors and students of the work for its intended academic, research, policy, implementation, evaluation for commercial and noncommercial uses deemed fit.

The agreement clearly delineates the Academic work of students and faculty is the proprietary information of the MSSW of MSSW (except that are already in public domain) and the Android App UI, designs, algorithms, database structure, icons, formulas, etc., are proprietary information of the CST. Proprietary Information (as defined below) disclosed by the Disclosing Party (MSSW or CST), either directly or indirectly to the recipient in connection with the App should be protected by the both parties against disclosure to any third party in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. Any breach to IP rights of the propriety information is noticed the parties shall inform the other promptly using any communication medium without delay to limit the damage and seek legal recourse based on avail at the affected parties' discretion or jointly by both parties by mutual consent.

The agreement recognizes that part of the social work students' academic, research, field and survey work in field of medical psychiatric, family welfare, HR, counseling casework, group work, may be of confidential in nature and CST will ensure that personal details directly referring to client will be masked or encrypted to protect its identity except to those are already in public domain. Students and faculty should clearly indicate all confidential information to be masked to CST for effective coding to prevent any accidental disclosure. In event of any accidental disclosure unintentionally CST will take corrective actions such as censor, withdrawal, banning, etc immediately within the reasonable working hours to limit the damage with the scope of Information Technology Act 2000 and International best practices.

Both parties shall exercise the same degree of care and protection of the Disclosing Party's Protected proprietary and confidential Information as the Recipient exercises with respect to its own Protected Information and should not directly or indirectly use, disclose or divulge the same to anyone in any

manner whatsoever, copy, photo-copy or re-produce, distribute, republish or allow any third party access to such Protected Information of the Disclosing Party without the prior written consent of the Disclosing Party. All Protected Information is provided "as is" and no Party makes any representations or warranties as to the accuracy or completeness of the Protected Information provided by it to the other.

The term "Proprietary Information" means, to the extent previously, presently or subsequently disclosed by or for Disclosure to Recipients, all student, faculty, clients, organizations, respondents, personal, social, economic and technical information of Disclosure or any of its affiliates, suppliers, customers and employees (including any and all non-public information, without limitation to code base, UI/UX, information about development, research, operations, marketing, transactions, permissions, compliance, discoveries, inventions, methods, processes, articles, materials, algorithms, software, specifications, designs, drawings, data, strategies, plans, prospects, customers, know-how and ideas, whether tangible or intangible, and including all copies, abstracts, summaries, analyses and other derivatives thereof), that is marked or otherwise identified as proprietary or confidential at the time of disclosure, or that by its nature would be understood by a reasonable person to be proprietary or confidential.

This MoU will be effective from the date of signing by both parties up to a period of five years and may be subject to extension by mutual consent of the parties in writing. The provisions of this MoU may be amended any time with mutual consent of the parties in writing. Either party may terminate the agreement by giving 6 (six) months advance notice in writing. The amendment, termination and expiration of this MoU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination or expiration, unless otherwise agreed upon between the two parties.

Each party shall use the logo to indicate their partnerships on websites briefly indicating the goals and objective of the partnerships. Further for projects both parties will seek approval from the other party in writing to use the later's name and logo for the activities hereunder on case to case basis and the other party will provide a reply at the earliest or maximum within 7 days in writing.

Both parties shall do their utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient implementation of the programme. Neither party can misuse this MoU by involving the name of the other stakeholder without written consent from the other party.

Jurisdiction

The MoU shall be governed by and constructed according to Laws in force in India. The parties hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts situated in Chennai for all purposes.

Arbitration

In case of any dispute or difference arising out of the MoU, which cannot be resolved mutually between two parties, it shall be referred to two arbitrators to be appointed by both parties in the proportion of one each. After hearing both parties the arbitrators will give reasoned and speaking award, which shall be binding on both parties. The venue of arbitration shall be Chennai, India.

Force Majeure

Neither party will be liable to the other for nonperformance of this MoU or any part thereof due to Force Majeure conditions, such as Acts of Gods, fire, floods, earthquakes, explosions, acts of sabotage, or terrorism, war, riots and any other circumstance (natural) beyond the control of the party.

Notices

Any notices to be given under this MoU shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly and properly served upon the parties hitherto if delivered against acknowledgement of by registered mail
